- To avoid further creation of new slums by reserving some extent of land in new layouts and annual Budget allocation for urban poor.

PRESENT STATUS OF THE PROJECT

- Slum Free City Plan of Action for 5 years is submitted for Rs.2223 Cr.
- Socio Economic House Hold Survey, Slum MIS Data entry, Total Station Survey and preparation of GIS maps are completed for all 111 slums. Integration of Slum MIS and GIS Maps is in progress.
- Detailed Project Repots for 2 pilot slums i.e. Dhall Mill Area & NSC Bose Nagar for Rs.121.95 Cr are prepared and submitted to Government for approval of SLSC. Preparation of DPR for Canal Hutting in Patamata (Ambedkar Nagar) is in progress.
- It is proposed to acquire 798.27 acres of land at Gollapudi as 60:40 basis (VMC-319.31 acres + Formers-478.96 acres) for relocating 20,000 house holds from hazardous slums.
- 22,000 families are living semi pakka and katcha houses as tenants.
- Total 30,000 houses are covered under RAY Programme.
- Houses will be constructed with Builders partnership.

BRIEF NOTE ON BRTS PROJECT

Main Corridor(15.5km loop corridor):

- Rs. 152.64 Crores had been sanctioned for BRTS Project under JnNURM.
- Construction of 40 bus stops through PPP and allotted 20 buses with ITS Facilities.
- New Road has been formed for a length of 3.3 Kms in abandoned SNPuram Railway Track
- One Four Lane Bridge across Eluru canal near Seethannapeta has been completed and one six lane bridge across Ryves canal at Madhura Nagar is in progress and will be completed by jan-2012.
- Footpaths, Drains, Widening of Road for M.G.Road completed.
- Widening and Formation of Karlmarx Road of 2.50 Km length from Ramavarapadu Ring to Padavalarevu was completed.
- Drains for Karlmarx Road and Jawaharalal Nehru Road completed and Footpaths are in progress.
- The O&M of the BRTS buses will be taken up by the APSRTC in their existing depot under the control of SPV. The SPV is under registration.

Feeder Corridor:

- **3**Kms length of Feeder Corridor connecting Madhuranagar Junction in BRTS Corridor with IRR at Pipula Road Junction is under development for better connectivity, the estimate prepared for Rs.8.00Cr.
- In this Feeder Corridor 2 numbers of Bridges across Eluru canal & Budameru Rivulet near Madhuranagar is in progress.
- Road Under Bridge (RUB) with 2 boxes are proposed under Madras Howrah Track at Singhnagar with 7.50 Cr is at final approval stage with Railway Authorities.

New roads:

- It is proposed to develop the identified five other main corridors and other 16 feeder corridors in next five years for better transport facilities in city.
- It is also proposed to develop the existing and new bridges in the city for better connectivity as identified in CTTS report.

VIJAYAWADA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION BRIEF NOTE ON UNDER GROUND DRAINAGE

- Five Projects have been sanctioned for Sewerage Sector under JnNURM to a tune of **Rs.271.48Cr.**
- Four Projects Completed so far and some of the works in one project are under progress
- Municipal Corporation has been taken up under ground drainage facilities in all unserved areas of the Vijayawada city by providing sewer collection network, laying of D.I. Pumping mains, construction of Sump cum Pumping stations, erection of Pump sets & Transformers etc. under JNNURM scheme.
- The Under Ground Drainage facilities to all the un-served areas of Vijayawada City have been completed and commissioned except one town area. At present, UGD Scheme works in one town area are nearing completion. It will be commenced by March 2012.
- Vijayawada is the city has reached out 100% coverage with sewerage facility after commissioning of UGD in One town area.
- An amount of Rs.210Cr. has been spent so far by the Vijayawada Municipal Corporation and the works are under progress for the remaining amount.
- 380Km. of Sewer Network Completed. 37Km. of Sewer Network under progress.
- 32 Sq.Km of area covered with sewer network against 36 Sq.Km of area. Sewer network for balance area under progress.
- 18Nos. of Sump cum Pumping Stations have been completed against 20Nos. The 2 Pumping Stations are under progress
- One 40MLD Capacity Sewage Treatment Plant has been commissioned, 3Nos. of 20MLD Capacity STPs are nearing completion and 1No. of 20MLD Capacity STP is under progress.
- Vijayawada Municipal Corporation has targeted to complete and commission all the balance works by March'2012.

Public Health

1. Dengue cases and Malaria:

Drastic reduction of Dengue cases from 159 in the year 2010 to just 17 cases in the year 2011. No deaths due to Dengue and Malaria.

2. Prevention of open urination and defecation:

Construction of new **BOT Toilets 15 number** at various needy places like Benz circle, Chitti nagar, Alluri Seetharamaraju vanthena, Taxi stand, opp Urvasi theatre, Kedareswaripeta, Besant Road Ansari park, Singh Nagar fly over bridge.

Provision of modern **portable toilets 15 numbers** at various public places and traffic junctions like Lenin center, Kummaripalem junction, Alankar theatre, old bus stand, police control room etc.,

3. Ban on Plastic:

Complete ban on plastic less than 40 microns in the city.

4. Bio Mining:

60 tonns of organic compost has been extracted from 5 acres of old dump at Excel plant.

5. Dog vaccination against rabies:

4000 street dogs are vaccinated.

6. City Sanitation plan

Formation of ward level 18 sanitation committees have been already formed, regular cleaning of drains once in 15 days.

7. Strengthening of UHCs:

Equipment like 22 Micro Scopes are provided to each of the UHCs. Salaries of the staff are enhanced. For Doctors Rs. 6000 – 11000, For ANMs Rs. 3000 – 4500. Capacity building of all the staff by arranging trainings teams from Hyderabad. New UHC buildings are under construction and 4 buildings have been completed at Madhura Nagar, Kandrika, New R.R.Peta and Singh Nagar.

8. Implementation of ESI, EPF:

For all the DWCUA and CMEY workers from April 2010

9. Information Education and Communication:

IEC has been prepared for 'No more Malaria', Dog menace, Ban on plastics, littering of garbage, Health and Hygiene, open urination and open defecation etc.

10. VMC Play School:

Play School at Ajith Singh nagar, Rajiv nagar for the children of P.H.Workers on public private partnership (1) Navajeevan Bala Bhavan, (2) Care and Share.
